SATURDAY MORNING FEATURES A **DANCE WORKSHOP** FOR THE PURPOSE OF LEARNING ALL MANNER OF DANCE AND ETIQUETTE IN PREPARATION FOR THE BALL. THE WORKSHOP BEGINS AT 9 AM, AND INCLUDES A LUNCH BREAK. COMFORTABLE MODERN ATTIRE IS APPROPRIATE. THE HALL WILL CLOSE AFTERWARDS, BUT WILL REOPEN AT 6:30 PM FOR THOSE WISHING TO USE THE DRESSING ROOMS.

**THE GRAND BALL**, "A TALE OF TWO CITIES", BEGINS ON SATURDAY NIGHT. THE DOORS TO THE PERIOD, CANDLELIT BALLROOM OPEN AT 7:30 PM, AND THE GRAND MARCH BEGINS PROMPTLY AT 8 PM. A FORMAL DINNER, FEATURING A MARVELOUS SPREAD OF PERIOD REPASTS, WILL BE SERVED DURING THE EVENING. FESTIVITIES WILL LAST INTO THE WEE HOURS OF THE MORNING.
